

**Lieutenant General Emerson C. Itschner
Scholarship Application**

The purpose of this scholarship is to recognize demonstration of high scholastic achievement and leadership potential in the area of engineering, thereby honoring General Itschner's belief in the value of talented professionals who can build and maintain the important professional relationship needed between the military and private industry to best serve our country. Scholarship funds will be distributed starting Fall term 2022.

Below are the minimum eligibility criteria to compete for this scholarship:

Part I

- 1) Have at least sophomore class standing at time of submission.
- 2) Have at least one academic year of school at OSU remaining.
- 3) Commit to attending the SAME Portland Post Chapter Meeting in May 2021 to receive the awards.
- 4) Active participation in the Oregon State University (OSU) Student Post of Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) or similar professional engineering organization or club.
- 5) Active participation in one of the OSU ROTC programs or full-time students in the College of Engineering.
- 6) Demonstrated leadership in managing projects or organizations.

Part II

- 7) Submit an essay on a separate page, in 200 to 500 words, explain why you feel you are deserving of the Itschner Scholarship and detailing how your selected area of study is relevant to the mission of SAME.
